**HAVING REGARD** to Managerial Decree No 15821/2024 Reg. 15821/ 2024 of 24/01/2024 accepting the donation made by QSC;

#### **HEREBY DECREES**

The issuance of the call for applications for 1 **"QSC" 2024 LM degree award**.

#### **Art. 1**

#### **Description of the degree award and recipients**

The LM award, worth **€5,000.00** gross each and inclusive of charges to be borne by Politecnico di Milano, shall be assigned for the best **LM** thesis on subjects related to: *"Innovation Technology and Sustainability"*.

The call is open to students who have obtained a LM degree from Politecnico di Milano in:

- Building Engineering Architecture
- Sustainable Architecture and Landscape Design
- Civil Engineering for Risk Mitigation
- Energy Engineering
- during the period from January 2023 to May 2024.
- with a degree score of at least 105/110

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met, using Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

## **Art. 2** **Application Procedure**

Applicants must submit an application using the relevant function available within Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements > Scholarships, degree awards, exemptions and general calls) **by 12.00 noon (Italian time) on 7 June 2024.**

Applicants **must attach**, through the appropriate procedure:

- their **LM thesis in PDF format, max. 10 MB**
- **a presentation** of their **LM thesis** highlighting its distinguishing features and the reasons for which it is deserving of the award (no more than four A4 pages in Italian or English) in a PDF file no larger than 5 MB
- 

The file must be named in the format Surname-Forename-Type of document.pdf (for example Smith-John-Thesis.pdf)

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. Applicants may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of the call for applications.

Failure to complete and submit the application or submission of an incomplete application will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.

**In the case of theses with multiple authors, each co-author that intends to apply for the award must submit an individual application.**

### **Art. 3** **Selection Board**

The award of the degree award shall be decided on the basis of a ranking list drawn up by a Selection Board appointed by managerial decree after the deadline of this call for applications.

In formulating the ranking, the board shall make a decision on the basis of the attachments uploaded through the appropriate procedure and their relevance and significance to the topic indicated in Art. 2

Provided that the requirements set out in Article 1 of the call for applications are met, the Board may divide the award among several candidates in the event of a tie.

The Selection Board may decide not to assign the award in the event that the none of the applicants are deemed eligible.

The winner may be invited to meet the donor

### **Art. 4** **General Rules**

**Non-cumulation:** this degree award cannot be combined with other awards received for the same thesis.

**Renunciation:** in case of renunciation by the winner, the degree award shall be assigned to the next applicant in the ranking.

**Payment:** the winner shall receive notification of being assigned the degree award at their University e-mail address. Within 10 days of receiving said notification, the winner must sign and return for acceptance the relevant forms attached to the award notification. The award shall be disbursed in a single payment by Politecnico di Milano.

**Taxation:** the amount awarded will be subject to taxation, in accordance with current legislation on scholarships. The degree award is treated as income equivalent to employment, and is therefore taxed accordingly. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the amount of the degree award.

**A. PURPOSES AND METHODS OF PROCESSING**

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforementioned purposes, the data processing shall be carried out by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner that is relevant and limited to what is necessary with regard to the purposes for which they are processed and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with the legislation in force.

#### **B. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF DATA PROVISION**

#### **E. DATA RETENTION PERIOD**
